

NHS Lancashire North Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) is working in partnership with the other seven CCGs in Lancashire to review clinical policies across the region.

Assisted conception services and cosmetic procedures are two of the clinical policies up for review and, should the draft policies be implemented, there may be a change in the service or treatments currently provided.

We want to invite you to attend a focus group to learn more about the revised clinical policies and give your views on them. Comments will be fed back to the CCG and the working group as part of the development process. Booking a place on the focus group is advised as space may be limited.

The Better Care Together team has been working on a project which has identified 4 pathways as the first priorities:


- Feverish Child
