The level of change identified above is a quick reference guide to the change in access to each of the procedures covered in the Cosmetics policy for your Clinical Commissioning Group area. This should be read in conjunction with the policy itself.

The fact that there is no change in access to a procedure, as identified above, does not necessarily mean that the procedure is routinely funded by your CCG. For example, tattoo removal was not funded previously and there has been no change to this. The correction of split ears was funded previously and will continue to be funded if the criteria are met.

This level of change document therefore, gives a quick overview of the change to each procedure. If you have an interest in a particular procedure or in the policy as a whole then please use this document with reference to the draft policy.

**Highlighted** – procedures that will not be routinely funded.
